December 1992

 - o Retaining income generated through the sale of PCSIR technologies, products and services.
 - o Working committee comprising various user agencies and relevant R&D organizations be created in various sectors to identify R&D needs of Trade, Industry and government institutions.
 - o Biotech Institute and CAMB to arrange joint International seminars.
 - o Creation of facilities for opto-electronics R&D with the collaboration of NIE, PAEC, Ministry of Communication and Institute of optics.
 - Strengthening of existing facilities of glass research in PCSIR.
 - o PASTIC should be developed into National Network for Decision implemented; only as a recommendation of information.

1993-1997

In 1997, the Secretariat of NCST was shifted to Pakistan Council for Science and Technology (PCST).

1997-2000

2002-2003

Follow-up of the implementation of the decisions of 2^{nd} and 3^{rd} meeting of NCST.

2003 - till date

- Minister for S&T discussed with the PM the matters regarding holding 4th meeting of NCST.
- o PM desired that the agenda should be really meaningful.
- PCST wrote several times to different stakeholders for viable agenda proposals.
- PCST received only limited agenda proposals appropriate for 4th meeting of NCST.
- Agenda for the 6th meeting of ECNCST is being drawn up with available information. The problem of poor response from various stakeholders will also be highlighted. Guidelines for the future role of ECNCST/NCST will be sought.
- Most of the decisions of 2nd and 3rd meetings of NCST have been implemented / or are being implemented through a number of projects by MoST, MoE, MoIT & TC, HEC, Universities, and related R&D organizations.
- Unfortunately none of these projects, as originally envisaged, was routed through the NCST Secretariat.
- Subsequent efforts to assess the implementation status of these projects by the NCST Secretariat were met with limited or practically no response.
- Under these circumstances, a policy decision regarding the status of NCST/ECNCST has become critical.
- In this connection an agenda for the sixth meeting of ECNCST is being prepared with information currently available with NCST Secretariat.
